**Renner Sports has been an environmentally responsible company for years** by striving to minimize our carbon footprint on the earth. We use recycled tires, recycle steel, and whenever possible, build over existing surfaces therefore eliminating the addition of old materials to a landfill.

- Recycled tires – over 2.5 million lbs. of recycled rubber are used every year in the resilient surfaces for tracks and tennis courts (rubber from over ¼ million tires).
- Recycle enough chain link for 2 miles of 10’ high fencing.
- Post-tensioned concrete tennis courts and running tracks are built on top of existing asphalt or reconstituted base, thus eliminating, on average, the disposal of 150 cubic yards of old material per court and 850 cubic yards per track.
- Steel recycled from reconstruction projects totals about 45,000 lbs. each year.
